Areas for research paper, poster and photo presentations:

- Quality in Healthcare,
- Technology Advancement in Diagnostics and Therapeutics
- Internet of Things (IOT) in Healthcare
- Low Cost Technology in Healthcare
- Patient Safety
- Clinical Information Safety
- Recent Techniques in Diagnostics or Therapeutics
- Any other topics related to the conference theme and sessions

Guidelines for research paper submission:

- All authors, sending papers are welcome to register and present their research papers in the conference. Once abstracts are accepted, the participants will be intimated accordingly.
- Full paper for presentation should be submitted on or before 30th December.
- All selected papers will be presented in the conference. However, the best among them will be considered for competition.
- The best papers selected in the award category may be considered for presentation in the common session of the conference.
- The abstract of the papers and posters selected for presentation may be published by the organizers.
- The abstract submission deadline for paper presentation competition will be closed one month before (10 December, 2019) the conference date hence all are requested to submit their abstracts well in advance.
- The abstract should include complete details of the contestant, abstract title, name, affiliation, materials and methodology, results and references. Abstracts have to be submitted through E-mail to : stjohnssummit2020@stjohns.in
- Shortlisted abstracts selected for the award category will be intimated by email and those will be displayed on the website (www.stjohns.in) as well.
- The abstract should be within the word limit of 300(excluding the author details and reference).

Technical details for the abstracts:

Font: Times New Roman, Font size: 12 • Spacing :1.5 ,Title page: Title, author(s), affiliation(s), email ID and mobile number.

The author or co-author can present selected paper in eight minutes (6 minutes for presentation and 2 minutes for question and answers).

Design of the study, methodology, presentation and answers to the questions of the judges will be the parameter for evaluation

Professionals and research scholars will be evaluated in the same category and PG students will be in another category.

The best abstracts will be selected for award category where the authors will be requested to submit their full paper before 20th December, 2019.

Author name, affiliation, summit register number and contact details shall be mentioned separately in the forwarding e-mail.

Guidelines for Poster presentations:

- All the posters shall be presented as e-posters. No printed or hard copies shall be accepted.
- Portrait (use poster template provided) • Size: A0 (87.1cm x 121.9cm)
- Title: large title (font size of 80 to 90 point)
- Authors: (font size of 50 to 60 point)
- Affiliations: (font size of 45 to 55 point)
- Headings: (font size of 40 to 50 point)
- Text: (font size of 30 to 40 point)
- Figures and tables may be used to present the results.
- Follow outline of abstract (Introduction, Methods, Result, Conclusion)
- Judgment will be done by board of jury on the basis of theme, design and methodology of the study
- During the event of poster competition, the presenting author must be present at the venue.
- Each participant will be given 6-8 minutes of time including question and answer session.

Guidelines for Photography competition:

- This item is open for UG students from all allied health disciplines.
- Photographs must be related to the theme or topics discussed in this summit.

- The student has to take a photograph and send the soft copy of the same to stjohnssummit2020@stjohns.in on or before 10 December, 2019.
- The participant must be present on site and registered participant of the conference.
